A more modern definition can be found in the Merriam-Webster dictionary which defines a planet as “any of the large bodies that revolve around the Sun in the solar system.” In 2006, the International Astronomical Union (IAU) - a group of astronomers that names objects in our solar system - agreed on their own definition of the word “planet.”

The solar system is located in one of the spiral arms of the Milky Way galaxy. It was born about 4.5 billion years ago when a cloud of interstellar gas and dust collapsed. Most of the material was pulled toward a central point: nearly all of the solar system's mass--99.8%--is in the Sun.

The Solar System formed from a huge cloud of gas and dust, which collapsed around 4.6 billion years ago. Clouds are usually triggered to collapse. It is thought that the shock wave from a nearby supernova explosion triggered the Solar System cloud to collapse. The cloud would have been very large and several stars, including our Sun, would have ...

Ceres is about 1/13 the width of Earth. The closest dwarf planet to the Sun, and the only dwarf planet in the inner solar system, Ceres orbits the Sun from an average distance of 257 million miles (413 million kilometers) Ceres is ...

Our solar system is moving with an average velocity of 450,000 miles per hour (720,000 kilometers per hour). But even at this speed, it takes about 230 million years for the Sun to make one complete trip around the Milky Way. The Sun rotates on its axis as it revolves around the galaxy. Its spin has a tilt of 7.25 degrees with respect to the ...

The inner solar system contains the Sun, Mercury, Venus, Earth and Mars: The main asteroid belt (not shown) lies between the orbits of Mars and Jupiter. The planets of the outer solar system are Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune (Pluto is now classified as a dwarf planet): The first thing to notice is that the solar system is mostly empty space.
