What is the solar energy potential in Albania?

Albania has an average of 2,400 hours of sun around 240-300 sunny days per year, with significant potential to exploit solar energy. The potential solar energy that could be generated per annum is calculated at approximately 1500-1700 kWh/m².

Does Albania cooperate with the EBRD to develop solar energy?

Albania cooperates closely with the EBRD to develop further solar policies. Albania takes further steps to develop the solar energy sector in close cooperation with the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD). What is the largest solar power plant in Albania?

In late 2023 the 140MW Karavasta solar power plant was completed, having taken Vitol of France 15 months to build, it is the largest in Albania to date. A 100 MW solar power project called Spitalla in Durrës area is planned to be built next.

Does Albania still have wind power?

Albania recently saw through the first competitive bidding procedure for wind power. Hydroelectric plants still make up almost 100% of the country's electricity production. The government is working on diversifying the mix with solar power and facilitate the construction of its first wind parks and gas-fired power plants.

What is the power transmission system in Albania?

Albania's electricity transmission system consists of lines with a voltage level of 110 kV, 150 kV, 220 kV and 400 kV, the respective substations at these voltage levels, and all equipment, the functions of which are included in the power transmission electrical.

Hydropower accounts for the largest share of Albania's electricity generation, representing around 95% of its installed power capacity. In addition, Albania has some of Europe's highest number of sunshine hours per year, presenting significant potential for the development of solar power and a good fit with existing hydropower capacity.

Albania embraces solar power with the Karavasta power station - 234,828 new solar panels generating 140 megawatts to power homes and protect local species. 53 families will be reimbursed for land appropriation to create this renewable energy facility.
