

Are there any government subsidies for energy storage projects in Denmark

Does Denmark have a CO₂ storage program?

Denmark has granted six licenses for exploration for CO₂ storage and has political agreements with several countries for cross-border transportation of CO₂ for geological storage under the seabed. Implementation of the new CCS Fund requires state-aid approval from the European Commission.

When will the Danish Energy Agency publish the tender material?

The Danish Energy Agency expects to publish the tender material in October 2024 and award contracts in April 2026 following a prequalification and negotiation round. See the public consultation material on the Danish Energy Agency's website.

Where can I find the tendering materials for the Danish Energy Fund?

The tendering materials are available on the CCS pages on the Danish Energy Agency website. Furthermore, the contract notice and tendering materials for the Fund will be published on the EU's electronic tendering platform: Tender Electronic Daily (TED).

Which companies were pre-qualified to participate in the Danish energy tender?

Three companies, I/S Vestforbrænding, Ørsted Bioenergy & Thermal Power A/S, and Aalborg Portland, were pre-qualified to participate in the tender, and all three of them submitted indicative offers and participated in negotiations with the Danish Energy Agency.

When will the Danish Energy Agency hold a follow-up information meeting?

The Danish Energy Agency plans to hold a follow-up information meeting about the tendering materials on 21 November 2024. All tendering materials are in English and all communication between potential tenderers and the Danish Energy Agency in connection with the tendering procedure must be via the "Digitale Udbud" tendering system.

When does the Danish Energy Agency's CCS consultation start?

The Danish Energy Agency's consultation will run until August 20, 2024, giving an opportunity for everyone, including potential bidders, to provide feedback on the CCS Fund. The Danish Energy Agency expects to publish the tender material in October 2024 and award contracts in April 2026 following a prequalification and negotiation round.

On April 17, 2024, it was announced that the Danish Energy Agency has awarded contracts to three companies: BioCirc CO₂ ApS, Bioman ApS, and Carbon Capture Scotland Limited, for new CCS projects, thereby concluding the NECCS Fund. Together, the projects will ensure the ...
