

Why should Thailand invest in rooftop solar PV systems?

Rooftop solar PV systems offer a transformative opportunity for Thailand to achieve its renewable energy targets, reduce dependence on fossil fuels, and empower consumers to participate in the energy transition.

What is Thailand's solar potential?

Thailand boasts a technical solar potential exceeding 300 GW, yet less than 2% of its land area is needed to achieve this. By 2037, the market potential for rooftop solar PV energy is projected at 9,000 MW. However, as of 2022, only 1,800 MW of rooftop solar PV capacity has been installed, representing a small fraction of this potential.

Is rooftop solar a viable solution for Thailand's energy transition?

Rooftop solar PV systems represent a promising solution to diversify Thailand's energy mix and empower consumers to participate in the energy transition. Despite its vast solar potential and declining technology costs, the adoption of rooftop solar remains significantly underutilized due to various barriers.

Will Thailand install 10 GW solar PV by 2037?

Thailand's government plans on installing more 10 GW solar PV by the end of 2037. To reach the goal, the appropriate level of incentives should be in place. Current buyback rate of 1.68 THB/kWh (0.05 USD/kWh) is not much attractive to customers.

How many solar farms are there in Thailand?

Out of which there are 2,631 MW of free-field installations (solar farms) and 130 MW of solar rooftops (see Table 1). 2016 has been another record year for solar in Thailand, with 740 MW of capacities already added in by the end of Q3-2016 (see Figure 1).

The Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand (EGAT) has launched a tender for a 205 MW hydro-floating solar hybrid project at the 779 MW Bhumibol Dam, the largest arch dam in Southeast Asia.

At the end of 2018, the cumulative installation of PV systems reached 3,437.34 MWp. It was increased 396.35 MWp. The systems can be divided into PV rooftop systems, ground-mounted PV power plants as well as floating PV systems. [At the end of 2018, the cumulative installation of PV systems reached 2,962 MWp of installation capacity in 2018.

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A 2kW solar panel system typically consists of 6-8 solar panels (depending on panel quality) and has a surface area of 10-15m². A 3kW system typically consists of 8-12 solar panels and covers a surface area of 15-20m². Because a 5kW system typically consists of 15-20 panels, the total rooftop space required for a 5kW system is between 25 and 35m².

3. Common photovoltaic power generation systems in Thailand. In Thailand, photovoltaic power generation systems are mainly divided into two types: home solar power system and commercial/industrial system. Home solar power system: Usually lower power inverters are used, generally in the range of 5-10 kilowatts (kW).

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
