The electricity tariff is largely subsidized; the average tariff of the state-owned electricity utility--Electricite du Liban (EDL)--is 9.5 cents for each kilowatt hour(kWh) consumed,while the cost of generation ranges from 17 to 23 cents/kWh. EDL thus incurs significant financial losses,between \$1.5-2 billion annually,depending on oil prices.

For a month running, Recycle Beirut and an adjacent residential building have been receiving all of the electricity they need with a microgrid that uses 100-kW of solar and a 100 kWh battery energy storage system. Small as it is, the microgrid's benefits are large.
