

Does Hungary need a state aid energy storage scheme?

Credit: Dorothy Chiron via Shutterstock. The European Commission has approved a EUR1.1bn (\$1.2bn) state aid energy storage scheme from the Government of Hungary.

Will Hungarian energy storage projects get subsidy support?

The Hungarian Ministry of Energy has announced that around 50 grid-scale energy storage projects with a cumulative capacity of 440 MW have received subsidy support through a tender launched in February this year.

Will Hungary support large-scale energy storage projects?

The European Commission has approved a EUR1.1 billion scheme from the government of Hungary to support large-scale energy storage projects.

Will Hungary provide grants for energy storage projects in 2025?

The Ministry of Energy in Hungary will provide grants for the deployment of energy storage projects, with some 1GWh targeted by 2025. From June, system operators and distribution companies will be able to apply for subsidies to build energy storage facilities by the summer of 2025 at the latest, the Ministry said.

How much does Hungarian government spend on energy storage projects?

The Hungarian government has allocated HUF 62 billion (EUR 158 million) for energy storage projects with an overall 440 MW in operating power. Hungarian authorities launched the tender for grid-scale batteries on January 15 and received offers until February 5. The winning bidders were selected a few days ago.

What is Hungary's energy storage goal?

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Domestic support for electricity storage may soon increase to more than HUF 300 bln, with several large storage facilities likely to be inaugurated this year, Energy Minister Csaba Lantos said in an interview with business daily Vilaggazdaság.

In the KÁT system, no new entitlement could be awarded from 2017, in the METR system green premium subsidy awarded as a result of a tender and brown premium are still available until 2026, however the amount to be awarded as a green premium new yearly subsidy has been decreased in 2021 by 45% for calendar years 2022-2026.

"This EUR1.1 billion Hungarian measure will facilitate the development of electricity storage capacity. The Hungarian electricity system will be more flexible," said Margrethe Vestager, executive vice-president of the European Commission in a statement.. The measure will be open to companies that are active in Hungary's energy sector, except financial institutions.

Additionally, HUF 33bn has been allocated for system operators and distributors to install grid-integrated energy storage systems. In a separate tender aimed at a wider range of companies, contracts are being signed to support the completion of 50 facilities by 2026 with HUF 62bn in state contributions.

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The subsidy takes the form of a low-interest loan with a maximum term of 15 years. In addition, at least 10% equity capital must be contributed. Subsidies can also be granted for the construction of charging stations with energy storage systems and/or systems for generating electricity from renewable energies.
