How can Cameroon achieve universal access to modern energy services?

The results show that achieving universal access to modern energy services in Cameroon requires prioritising investments in grid densification, extension, and modernisation, along with distribution systems. It is also found that mini grid PV systems can play a significant role in meeting Cameroon's electrification goals.

How will Cameroon develop its electricity sector?

In its National Development Strategy 2020-2030, Cameroon has set significant targets for the development of its electricity sector: at least an additional 3,500 MW by 2035 and about 1 million new connections to achieve the universal access to electricity by 2035.

How to increase energy access in Cameroon?

Reducing the large inefficiencies in the generation and distribution of electricity would also mobilise substantial domestic finance to invest in grid densification and extension. In addition, intra-regional technical cooperation is imperative to increase energy access in Cameroon.

ENEO Cameroon (formerly AES-SONEL) is a state-owned Cameroonian company responsible for the production, distribution and marketing of electricity in Cameroon. It is also responsible for the maintenance and repair of electricity distribution networks, and for consumer billing.

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English-Speaking Cameroon 1929: The Luermann and Malale hydroelectric power plants were inaugurated and supplied electricity to the Muyuka region. This was mainly intended for homes and factories of colonists (private initiative). 1946: A public electricity utility entity was created to supply electricity which was bought mostly from private plants installed by colonists.

However, challenges with the transmission network, managed by the National Electricity Transmission Company (Sonatrel), have led to rationing in certain areas. In Douala, key transmission nodes like Logbaba, Bassa, Makepe, Bakoko, and Ngodi Bakoko are overloaded, making the system vulnerable to demand spikes.
