



Can I bring a portable power bank to North Korea

Are power banks banned in South Korea?

South Korea implemented nationwide restrictions that took effect this month, banning passengers from storing power banks and e-cigarettes in overhead cabins on all of the country's airlines. Passengers can store power banks either in the seat pocket or under the seat.

Can you carry a power bank on a plane?

Power banks between 100Wh and 160Wh require airline approval at the check-in counter. Separately, there are no limits on carrying dry cell alkaline batteries (think Energizer Bunny batteries), according to the FAA, as long as the voltage does not exceed 12 volts and are "protected from damage."

Can you use a power bank on a Thai Airlines Flight?

Thai Airways announced passengers are no longer allowed to use or charge power banks on flights from March 15, following "incidents of in-flight fires on international airlines, suspected to be linked to power bank usage."

Can I carry a power bank on Air Asia?

Air Asia: Guests may only carry power banks that do not exceed 100 watt-hours (Wh) or 20,000 milliampere-hours (mAh). Power banks between 100Wh and 160Wh require airline approval at the check-in counter.

Can you use a power bank on Singapore Airlines?

Starting in April, Singapore Airlines is banning passengers from using power banks to charge phones and personal devices in-flight. Power banks are also not allowed to be charged using aircraft USB ports.

Do you need a power adapter in Korea?

North Korea uses 220 voltage and plug types A and F. If you're traveling from a country that uses a different voltage or plug type, you may need an adapter. When shipping a power bank or portable charger overseas, make sure that lithium batteries are safely enclosed inside the device and keep the battery charge to a maximum of 30%. The relevant transport recommendations for every device model can be found in the product information sheet of the manufacturer.

Several airlines in Asia are tightening rules on carrying lithium batteries on planes following a series of overheating and fire incidents on board.

Yoo Kyung-soo, director general of the ministry's Aviation Safety Policy Bureau, said, "If a power bank is deemed to be the cause of the Air Busan fire, we will discuss with the International Civil Aviation Organization consideration of more regulations like limiting the number of battery packs in carry-on luggage." msjeon22@korea.kr
