Do I have to follow USPS international shipping regulations?

When you ship something from the United States to another country, you must follow both USPS international shipping regulations and the regulations of the destination country: Some items are prohibited (completely forbidden). Some are restricted (allowed under certain conditions).

Do you need a power adapter?

An adapter will allow you only to plug your appliance into another type of outlet. Most are small and lightweight, making them easy to pack. If you're packing lots of devices, you should invest in multiple adapters so that you can charge all of your electronics at once.

Do I need a converter for a 240 volt power supply?

If your device is dual-voltage, you can safely use it for voltages anywhere between 120 V and 240 V. In this case, you'll only need a plug adapter. If you see something like 'INPUT AC 120/240 V 50--60 Hz 1300 W' on your device, it means it's dual-voltage. Travel Smarter!

What are the certification requirements for external power supplies?

Per 10 CFR 430.32 (w) (4), external power supplies must bear an obvious and permanent marking that complies with the International Efficiency Marking Protocol for External Power Supplies. 10 CFR Part 429 sets certification requirements for products covered by 10 CFR Part 430, which includes external power supplies. These requirements include:

Do I need a travel adapter for my devices?

When traveling abroad, you need to know what type of adapter is needed to plug your devices into the outlet. All electrical sockets are not created equal, and you should ensure you have the right travel adapter for your destination.
