

Can a 110v inverter be converted to 220v

If it has an extra horizontal bit (like this), then you can't do it if the A/C unit takes more than 2400 watts. Next, you'll need a 240-120V step-up/down transformer whose watts (or VA) rating is larger than the air conditioner. To run 220V from breaker box, an electrician would have to start at the breaker box, install a 220V enabled breaker and run a 220V wire all the way around the house to the desired 220V location. What would an electrician have to do to get the two 110V outlets to be functioning in the way that this converter would be able to convert to 220V?

In the first case, the step-down transformer would work, but it would seem far easier to use half of the 220V circuit and the neutral to get 120V. The second option can't be accomplished. The welders innards won't handle the additonal current. Hank

The key is to know how the inverter [neutral] is grounded and how your service is grounded, in all modes of operation. If you have a split-phase 120/240V inverter on a 120/240V grid service in the US the neutral is generally never broken/opened, so the typical installation the grid service provides the neutral-ground bond at the first disconnect.
