It's time to replace the battery in the camper and I am considering installing a 150ah AGM battery. The only way I can get it in is to install it on its side. The battery is an Amp-Tech and the web site states "Fully Sealed AGM batteries give added safety in rough conditions. No danger of battery acid spills.

The positioning question probably arises from the notes about it being ok to use "prismatic" lifepo4 batteries, and even lead-acid agm batteries sideways, but NOT upside down. The prismatic lifepo4's, along with agm's, have vents on the top in case of an overcharge condition to vent.
