Each battery or cell must be entirely enclosed to prevent contact with other equipment or any conductive materials.

Regulations difer depending upon what type of lithium battery you are shipping (lithium ion or lithium metal) and whether you are shipping batteries packed with equipment or ...

Also available in power and energy cells, these types of cells can be used in batteries designed to meet sealed lead acid battery dimensions. While dimensionally larger than a cylindrical cell, prismatic cells pack more

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amp-hours per cell by having more lithium by volume, allowing for larger battery pack configurations and single-cell options.

Lithium Ion battery (rechargeable) - exceeding 100Wh and up to 160Wh. Lithium ion batteries over 160Wh are forbidden as passenger baggage and must be sent as freight. Lithium Ion batteries must be declared during check-in. Only two spares per passenger. Non- rechargeable lithium metal batteries are limited to 2 grams of lithium per battery.

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
