What is an outdoor Uninterruptible Power Supply?

Is an external power supply required?

An external power supply is required for devices like printers, displays, pin pads, external DVD-ROMs, and hard drives. Unfortunately, the bus supplied power is limited to 2.5 Watts (0.5A @+5V) per port, sufficient to provide enough power to input devices, web cameras, and other low power devices.

Do I need a GFCI outlet if I run power outside?

When running power outside, a GFCI-equipped outlet is required by code in all areas exposed to moisture, such as the outdoors, and ensures safety. When adding an outdoor outlet, be sure to choose an outdoor-rated, weatherproof model with built-in, high-sensitivity GFCI.

The components can be used indoors or outdoors. o The power supply can be plugged directly into an outdoor receptacle that has a cover that can be closed over the device. The main body of the power supply is 2-5/8" tall X 1-3/4" wide so it takes up two receptacle spots.

Wiring #3: Use Multiple Power Supplies. Sometimes, rather than run long lengths of wire and split up the wires going from the power supply, customers will choose to use separate power supplies in different areas. This works great if you can supply power in the specific places you would need them, but that is the tricky part.

On my current outdoor cams I have 2 that run solely on solar, the outdoor cams use between 400ma (day) and 550ma (night) each camera. So between the 2 cameras on average 23,000-25,000 mAh is consumed by the 2 camera per day I originally had one 120 watt panel which fell short at times so I added another 120 watt panel to system.
