How does the Democratic Republic of the Congo support the economy?

In the AC, Democratic Republic of the Congo supports an economy six-times larger than today's with only 35% more energy by diversifying its energy mix away from one that is 95% dependent on bioenergy.

Most power generation development is directed and funded by mining companies seeking to power their facilities.

Could hydropower power the DRC & Zambia?

Hydropower in the DRC and Zambia already forms the backbone of their modest energy supply. Projects like the long-delayed Grand Inga Hydropower Dam on the Congo River, if revived, could unleash 40GW of electricity -- enough to power large-scale industrial growth across the region. Smaller, decentralized renewable energy systems also hold promise.
