Was the Colombian anti-dumping investigation flawed?

The report under appeal found that the Colombian anti-dumping investigation was flawed in several respects. Both the EU and Colombia are participants in the Multi-Party Interim Appeal Arbitration Arrangement pursuant to Article 25 of the DSU (known as the 'MPIA').

Did Colombia impose anti-dumping duties on frozen fries?

In this dispute, the EU challenged the anti-dumping duties imposed by Colombia on frozen fries from Belgium, the Netherlands and Germany. Exports of frozen fries from the three Member States to Colombia amounted to EUR23 million in 2016.

Why did Colombia appeal the panel report?

On 6 October 2022, Colombia appealed the panel report. The full text of the panel report is annexed to Colombia's Notice of Appeal. The report under appeal found that the Colombian anti-dumping investigation was flawed in several respects.

Can the EU challenge Colombia's frozen fries tariffs?

Anti-dumping measures. Anti-dumping measures can be put on imports of specific products if the Commission's anti-dumping investigation justifies it. These measures are usually in the form of an "ad valorem" duty. Other measures that can be applied include a fixed or specific amount of duty or, in some cases, a minimum import price.
