

What is the solar energy potential in Colombia?

The potential of solar energy at a global level in Colombia is 4.5 kW h/m²/day and the area with an optimal solar resource is the Peninsula de la Guajira, with 6 kW h/m²/day of radiation, surpassing the world average of 3.9 kW h/m²/day. Why are photovoltaic systems important in Colombia?

The implementation of photovoltaic systems in Colombia has enabled 2% of the population in areas that do not have access to electric energy to meet their lighting, refrigeration and leisure needs, allowing them to expand their capacities and improve their quality of life. The systems that have been installed are mainly focused on the rural sector.

Is solar energy a problem in Colombia?

How many people use electricity in Colombia?

In terms of the number of households that have access to the electricity grid in Colombia, it is currently provided with 12.1 millions since 2005, represented by 95.8% of the total Colombian population, identifying that of the total electricity generated around 70% of the consumption is residential.
