What is a solar co-op?

A solar co-op is made up of individuals, businesses, or both, partnering up to meet their shared energy needs and typically receiving bulk discounts. This is not to be confused with community solar, which is defined as any solar project or purchasing program in which the benefits of a single solar array or project flow to multiple customers.

How much do solar panels cost?

If you just need a few panels for a small do-it-yourself solar project, expect to pay around \$200 to \$350 per panel (between \$0.80 and \$1.40 per watt). Note: The table below doesn't include the cost of a solar storage battery, which can add anywhere from \$7,000 to \$18,000 to your total system costs. Average solar panel system cost by system size

How much does a solar system cost per watt?

A solar installation's "cost per watt" is a little like the "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes. Expect the cost per watt to be between \$2 to \$3. As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84. Solar panels typically pay for themselves within 5 to 15 years.

How much does a rooftop solar system cost?

Mounting system: This is what holds rooftop solar panels in place. Costs vary depending on the type of solar installation, but it generally costs between 7 and 20 cents per watt. Electrical wiring and hardware: This includes the wiring, switches and circuit breakers required to connect the solar panel system to your home's electrical system.

This all depends on the size of the system, your energy consumption and the cost to purchase or lease the solar system. To help gauge changes in our rates, from 2000 to 2008, DEC averaged an annual rate increase of about two-percent.

Because we are a cooperative, the rates at Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative (SSVEC) are different from an investor-owned company like Arizona Public Service (APS) or Tucson Electric Power (TEP).
