How can Cuba build a more resilient energy system?

Building a Cleaner, More Resilient Energy System in Cuba recommends numerous ways by which domestic policy in Cuba can prioritize working towards a more sustainable, resilient grid -- especially by investing in the energy transition-- and ways in which international cooperation can support these goals.

Photovoltaic panels. Source: Amaury Pérez Sánchez So far in Cuba, 227 MW have been installed in photovoltaic systems connected to the electricity system, of which 215 MW in 72 farms synchronized with the Electric System and 12 MW installed on roofs and areas belonging to the entities.

Is Cuba's energy infrastructure in a precarious state of aging and disrepair?

The report highlights the issue that not only is Cuba's energy infrastructure in a precarious state of aging and disrepair, but also that its entire energy system relies heavily on external aid and imported fossil fuels.

Should Cuba update its energy grid?

While small-scale, such renewable energy initiatives can reduce pressure on the energy grid and provide relief in especially vulnerable places. Due to rising temperatures and increasingly unreliable energy infrastructure, action to update Cuba's energy grid is urgently necessary.

How does Cuba rely on oil?

Cuba is dependent on fossil fuels for energy generation and relies on oil imports of crude and fuel oil from Venezuela and Russia, as well as floating power plants provided through an agreement with a Turkish business group.

By 2030, Cuba aims to have 24% of electrical generation from renewable sources. Cuba's INDC commits to 19 bioelectric power plants fueled with wood and/or sugar cane residue (755 MW), 13 wind farms (633 MW), solar photovoltaics (700 MW), and 74 small hydroelectric plants for a total of 2,144 MW of renewable energy by 2030.

By March, the Antonio Guiteras Thermal Power Plant experienced breakdowns, leaving several provinces without power. The situation worsened in May and June, with some regions enduring outages for up to 12 hours daily.
