What is Côte d'Ivoire energy?

Côte d'Ivoire Energies (CI-ENERGIES): the state-owned entity responsible for monitoring and managing the electricity system. It also manages projects for which the state acts as the conceding authority.

How many households in Côte d'Ivoire have electricity?

Côte d'Ivoire recorded 375,533 new households with electricity, including 251,133 connections funded by PEPT, a 2014 program which allows households with low incomes to pay for electricity over a 10-year period after an advance payment of 1,000 CFA (about \$2).

The city of Boundiali. Image: Saft. A lithium-ion battery energy storage system (BESS) made by Saft will be installed at a 37.5MWp solar PV power plant in Côte d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast).

The Boundiali solar PV plant is built at a cost of EUR40 million, and the financing agreements were signed in 2019. The solar project is financed by a concessional loan of EUR27 million from the German development bank KfW and a grant of EUR9.7 million from the European Union (EU). The Ivorian state contributed the remaining sum to reach the necessary financing.

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
