It can be seen that the Gambia's capacity has increased to 167MW as at the end of 2021. This means that the country's electricity capacity has increased by 65MW. To meet the target of 250MW by the end of 2025, the Gambia will need to increase its electricity capacity by a further 85MW in the next three years.
