What is a 12V power supply?

The 12V power supply is designed to convert an input voltage (usually AC) into a stable 12-volt DC output, suitable for a variety of electronic devices and systems. Its job may seem straightforward, but its impact is huge. When you need stable and reliable power for sensitive equipment, a 12V power supply can be your best friend.

How many +12V sources does a power supply have?

Cool => There are a few units that actually have two +12V sources, but these are typically very high output power supplies. And in most cases these multiple +12V outputs are split up again to form a total of four, five or six +12V rails for even better safety.

What is the output current of a 12V power supply?

What do you need to know about a power supply?

Here are the most important ones to know: Output Voltage: This should be 12V, but it's crucial to verify that it remains stable under various conditions. Output Current (Amps): Determines the maximum load the power supply can handle without overheating. Power Rating (Watts): This is calculated by multiplying output voltage and current (12V $\times$ Amps).

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A voltage source does not have a constant resistance. Rating current of voltage source is a supply current value when the output voltage reduces in some percentage, normally say 10%. For a consumption product, resistance is function of supply voltage (not linear) Rating current is average value and make a consumption power.

Say you have a triple output DC power supply, providing 5V and +/-12V. Generally there will be a separate "terminal for the 5V rail and for the +/-12V rails. Since they are floating, you can use the +/-12V rails to make a +24V supply, and connect the -12V output to Earth ground if you want it Earth ground referenced.

I think the OP is under the impression that the 12v trigger output of an AV receiver supplies a constant 12v that can be used to power a device.
