What is the first solar-plus-storage project in the Dominican Republic?

Construction has started on the first major solar-plus-storage project in the Dominican Republic, which features a 24.8MW/99MWh battery energy storage system (BESS). Policy Options Carbon Price. A price on carbon, such as a greenhouse gas cap-and-trade program, would raise the cost of electricity produced from fossil fuels relative to low-carbon sources. Dominican Republic Renewable Energy Incentives. The Dominican government is actively promoting the adoption of solar panels and battery storage systems through various incentives and grants. These initiatives are part of the country's broader effort to diversify its energy matrix and reduce its dependence on imported fossil fuels.

The Renewable Energy Incentives Law (57-07) grants several incentives to businesses developing renewable energy technologies. This law was passed in 2007 as part of the Dominican government's efforts to invigorate local energy generation from renewable sources, as well as to promote the production of high-value renewable energy products.

The Dominican Republic is rapidly integrating renewable energy sources into its national grid. By 2025, they aim to achieve 25% renewable energy dependence. This ambitious goal has spurred significant growth, with renewable energy contributing nearly 19% of the country's total energy demand in 2023. However, challenges remain.
