

What percentage of PV & EES modules are installed in 2024?

As our PV & EES InstallerMonitor report shows, modules above 450 W account for as much as 19% of the capacity installed in 2024 by installers active in the commercial segment, compared to only 9% for residential-only installers.

Where will solar panels be installed in Romania?

Romania's Ministry of Energy has given the green light to a 1.5 GW solar panel factory to be built in the northeastern part of the country. Hungary has decided to allow apartment owners to jointly install solar panels and will only permit solar plants equipped with grid-connected inverters from July 2025.

How much solar power does Europe have in 2024?

The bulk of EU solar power comes from building installations, which make up around two-thirds (over 220 GW) of current EU solar capacity. Despite a recent slowdown in the rooftop segment, it still provided close to 60% of Europe's newly installed solar capacity in 2024, and the prominence of rooftop solar is unlikely to change in the foreseeable future.

Are small-scale PV and EES projects driving market growth?

While small-scale PV and EES projects have historically driven market growth, there is a distinct and gradual shift toward commercial & industrial (C&I) and utility-scale projects. The shift away from small-scale residential PV projects is driven by several macroeconomic and policy factors.

Will smart solar buildings meet Europe's energy security needs by 2030?

Our modelling shows, that by 2030, smart solar building solutions could meet more than half of EU daily energy system flexibility needs, and a third of its annual flexibility needs. That means a more cost-effective system, resilient to shocks and strengthening Europe's energy security.

What percentage of PV systems were installed in 2023 & 2024?

Furthermore, in a survey of more than 6,000 participants by EUPD Research's SolarProsumerMonitor report; 2024/2025 in Germany, 28% of the PV owners stated that their PV system was installed in 2023 and 16% in 2024. With regard to storage, 36% of participants stated to have acquired a residential storage system in 2023 and a smaller percentage in 2024.
