

Egypt's photovoltaic power generation

What percentage of solar PV installations are in Egypt?

Solar PV capacity accounted for 13.0% of total power plant installations globally in 2022, according to GlobalData, with total recorded solar PV capacity of 1,109GW. This is expected to contribute 30% by the end of 2030 with capacity of installations aggregating up to 4,002GW. Of the total global solar PV capacity, 0.19% is in Egypt.

Where can solar power be developed in Egypt?

Utility-scale PV development has, thus far, clustered around Aswan in the south of the country, where solar resources are strongest and there is plenty of land for development. The biggest chunk of Egyptian solar capacity is provided by the Benban project, which lies 50 km from Aswan and is one of the world's biggest PV sites.

Does Egypt have solar power?

The sun shines 9-11 hours a day from north to south, with few cloudy days. The World Bank highlights that Egypt has excellent solar resources with electricity-generating potential estimated at 73,656 terawatt-hours (TWh). According to the US International Trade Administration, the first solar thermal power plant was built in 2011 in Kuraymat.

What is Egypt's first solar plant?

The 1.8-gigawatt installation is the first utility-scale PV plant in Egypt, a nation blessed with some of the best solar resources on the planet. The ambitious project is part of Egypt's efforts to increase its generation capacity and incorporate more renewable sources into the mix.

Does Egypt have a high photovoltaic power potential?

This map shows high photovoltaic power potential in Egypt, where the sun shines for 9 to 11 hours a day all year. Egypt began laying the groundwork for the US \$4 billion Benban project after enduring repeated blackouts, caused by severe fuel shortages, that reached their worst point in August 2014.

What is Egypt's energy mix?

The resulting revenue, combined with falling PV component costs, has changed the landscape of Egyptian energy economics. The latest figures published by Egypt's New and Renewable Energy Authority (NREA) indicate the country's power generation mix is currently 80% thermal, 12% wind, 6% hydro, and 2% solar.
