Can solar energy be exported to the grid?

In many jurisdictions, regulations mandate limitations on the export of solar energy to the grid. Zero export devices ensure compliance with these regulations, avoiding potential penalties or restrictions imposed on solar installations that exceed export limits.

What is solar export control?

In essence, solar export control refers to the amount of solar power you can send to the grid from a grid-connected solar installation. These limits can apply to any size of solar installation, from utility-scale projects to solar panels on private residences. Suppose a solar plant produces more electricity than can be supplied to the grid.

How do I integrate zero export devices into a solar energy system?

Integrating zero export devices into a solar energy system requires careful planning and consideration of various factors. The system design should account for the specific energy needs of the property, the size and capacity of the solar array, and the compatibility of the chosen zero export solution.

What are China's solar PV exports?

In 2021, the value of China's solar PV exports was over USD 30 billion, almost 7% of China's trade surplus over the last five years. Does a solar export control device need to be included?

In a solar system, the inverter can convert the DC power to AC power, which supplies the load first and the excess will be injected into the grid. However, due to the need to maintain grid quality, not all countries or electricity companies can allow generators to export to the grid, so the need to control zero output has arisen.

So even in a worst-case situation for Sydney, an 8 kilowatt solar system that is exported limited to 5 kilowatts will only lose 4% of generation. While losses increase as the solar power system size goes up, even with 10 kilowatts of panels which is twice the export limit, only 13% of generation is lost.
