

Government subsidies for energy storage systems in Australia

Is there a subsidy for batteries in Queensland?

There's now no subsidy for batteries in Queensland. National solar subsidy - available across New South Wales for all system sizes, the national STC scheme can reduce the upfront cost of a 6.6kW system installed in Sydney by around \$2,000. Note that system prices advertised in New South Wales would already factor in this amount.

How much is a solar battery subsidy?

Home and business battery scheme: Eligible businesses and homeowners can receive a \$400 subsidy for each kilowatt-hour of usable battery system capacity, with a maximum incentive of \$5,000. Finding the right solar incentives

What is a national solar subsidy?

National solar subsidy - this incentive significantly reduces the cost of buying solar panels. For example, in the case of a 6.6kW system installation in Melbourne, it can provide (approximately) a \$1,700 discount in 2025. Are there any state government incentives for solar batteries?

There are currently no state government incentives for solar batteries if you live in Queensland or Tasmania. Solar Victoria offers interest-free loans of up to \$8,800 to help slash the upfront cost of installing a solar battery. This program aims to boost self-sufficiency and save you money on energy bills.

What is the Small-scale Renewable Energy Scheme (SRES)?

The Australian Government's Small-scale Renewable Energy Scheme (SRES) reduces the cost of most new residential and business rooftop solar systems. Rebates and loans are also provided by some state and territory governments and local councils to help with the cost of a battery.

Are solar battery rebates available in Australia?

Solar battery systems traditionally have not enjoyed the same solar rebates in Australia. But some recent government solar battery rebates, and solar battery subsidies, are available to support the purchase of solar batteries. There are currently no state government incentives for solar batteries if you live in Queensland or Tasmania.

The Community Batteries for Household Solar program will install 400 batteries to provide shared storage for households across Australia. The batteries will store excess solar energy for families and households to use ...

The Queensland Government has a range of energy saving programs designed to help businesses save energy



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and adopt energy-efficient practices. The Business Energy Savers Program provides free energy audits for agricultural customers and large business customers, and co-contributions to fund energy efficiency upgrades.

To access the subsidy on the solar battery, you need to make sure you purchase from a Clean Energy Council Approved and qualified system provider. The qualified system providers will advise on the required South Australia government-approved battery systems for home battery subsidy.

Western Australia Energy Buyback Schemes. The Western Australian government offers energy buyback schemes, which provide a feed-in tariff for excess electricity generated by solar PV systems. This means that households with solar panels can sell any excess energy they generate back to the grid and receive a credit on their electricity bills.

In the Northern Territory, the Home and Business Battery Scheme supports the NT Government's plan for 50% renewable energy by 2030 and enables home and business owners to apply for a grant to install a rooftop solar system and home battery, or add a home solar battery storage to an existing solar PV system.
