Are power points suitable for outdoor installation?

Power points meant for outdoor installation are designed to stand up to the rigours of the natural elements. Unlike indoor outlets, they are exposed to the elements 24/7 and are constructed using UV-stabilised materials to protect them from damage.

How high should outdoor receptacles be positioned?

The principal rules for outdoor receptacles include: GFCI (ground-fault circuit-interrupter) protection is required for all outdoor receptacles. Specific exceptions may be made for snow-melting or deicing equipment, where the equipment is powered by an inaccessible outlet.

How many outdoor receptacles should a house have?

Homes must have at least one outdoor receptacle at the front and rear of the house. They must be readily accessible from the ground and positioned no more than 6 1/2 feet above grade (ground level).

The quick answer is that you should have no more than ten outlets connected to a 20-amp circuit for fire safety reasons. However, it actually depends on what is drawing power from those garage outlets. The maximum power draw of an outlet is 15 amps. In theory, you should be able to install one outlet on a 20-amp circuit, and have 5 amps to spare.

You can never be too careful where something as volatile as electricity is concerned, especially in a high-risk area like the bathroom. Safety switches monitor the flow of electricity through a circuit and automatically cut the power supply if current is detected leaking from faulty switches or wiring.

The best place to install the outdoor component is in a shaded area away from direct sunlight and heat sources. This will prevent the unit from overworking and increase its lifespan.
