

How long can the UPS be used

How long does an ups last?

Although a UPS has an expected lifespan of eight to 13 years, several factors can shorten or lengthen it. The most important factor is how frequently you use it. The more you use it, the faster it will wear out. If you live in an area with rare brownouts and blackouts, the UPS doesn't need to work as hard, thus extending its lifespan.

How long do UPS batteries last?

It is known that batteries of a UPS either would last 3 to 5 years for VRLA and 8 to 10 years for Lithium Ion, in optimal operating conditions. Battery service life is subject to ambient temperature, the quality of input power, and the application the UPS is used in.

Don't keep your UPS unused for more than three months. Even if you don't use it, recharge the battery to prevent it from losing its capacity. Unplugging the unit at night can reduce its lifespan because the battery will self-discharge when it isn't connected to the power supply.
