This is actually a chemical characteristic of the lithium-ion system. Each battery cell has a nominal voltage of 3.6 volts and a maximum voltage of just over 4 volts. 3.6 volts (nominal) x 5 cells = 18 volts; 4 volts (maximum) x 5 cells = 20 volts; That's it. That's the entire difference between 18V vs 20V Max batteries.
