



How many volts is the outdoor power supply in Yemen

What is the standard voltage in Yemen?

In Yemen the standard voltage is 230 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. You can use your electric appliances in Yemen, if the standard voltage in your country is in between 220 - 240 V (as is in the UK, Europe, Australia and most of Asia and Africa). Manufacturers take these small deviations into account.

Do I need a power plug adapter or voltage converter in Yemen?

What type of plug sockets are in Yemen?

Also, a transformer is required as the voltage in Yemen may be different than in Europe. Can Europeans use Electronics in Yemen without an adapter? No! Most Europeans may need a travel adapter when

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traveling to Yemen. Most device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Yemen. However, the voltage in Yemen is the same as in Europe.
