How many amps can a 20W solar panel produce?

To find out the required solar panel output with a buffer, you can use the formula: Required output (Watts) $\times$ 1.20. For example, with a 20% buffer for a 6 kW system, the required solar panel output would be 7.2 kW.

How many watts of solar panels do I Need?

You need around 800-1000 watts of solar panels to charge most of the 48V lead-acid batteries from 50% depth of discharge in 6 peak sun hours with an MPPT charge controller. You need around 1600-2000 watts of solar panels to charge most of the 48V lithium batteries from 100% depth of discharge in 6 peak sun hours with an MPPT charge controller.

Remember not to confuse Amps with Watts. Volts X amps = Watts. Your 10 watt panel on a perfect day at solar noon puts out about .8 amps and your 20 watt panel on a clear day at solar noon puts out about 1.5 amps. Most of the other times you will get approximately half the output. On a cloudy day output will be almost zero.

Solar Panels power generation is commonly given in Watts e.g. 120 Watts. To calculate the energy it can supply the battery with, divide the Watts by the Voltage of the Solar Panel. 120 Watts / 18v = 6.6 Amps. Please note that Solar Panels are not 12v, I repeat Solar Panels are not 12v.

For instance, the 100-watt solar panel from our example has an Imp rating of 5.62 Amps. This means that when this solar panel is producing 100 Watts of power under Standard Test Conditions, It will be generating 5.62 Amps of current.
