

How many watts do solar lights usually cost

How many Watts Does a solar light system use?

Most solar lighting systems use fixtures ranging from 20 Watt LED (2000+Lumens) to 90 Watt LED (9000+Lumens) and are typically in the 35 Watt to 50 Watt range for most applications. High security or light level requirements use the brighter lights and residential and remote areas use the lower range.

How much does a solar panel cost?

What is the cost per watt for solar?

The cost per watt for solar is currently approximately \$0.22(August 2016). This is about 16p per watt at today's conversion rates. The price per watt has seen a significant drop across all types of installed solar.

How much solar power do we receive?

In part 1 of our Learn Solar series, we discussed the factors determining the solar power we receive. According to David JC MacKay, the sun provides an average energy (over one year) of 876 kWh/m²; for flat ground, and 964 kWh/m²; for south-facing roofs. However, we cannot capture all of that energy.
