How much does a solar panel cost?

Today's premium monocrystalline solar panels typically cost between 30 and 50 cents per Watt, putting the price of a single 400-watt solar panel between \$120 to \$200 depending on how you buy it. Less efficient polycrystalline panels are typically cheaper at \$0.25 per Watt. The cost of a solar panel also depends on how you buy it.

How much does a solar system cost per watt?

A solar installation's "cost per watt" is a little like the "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes. Expect the cost per watt to be between \$2 to \$3. As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84. Solar panels typically pay for themselves within 5 to 15 years.

How much does a polycrystalline solar panel cost?

Blue-tinted polycrystalline panels cost less - around \$0.95 per watt. They're made from silicon fragments and reach about 16% efficiency. They don't handle heat or shade as well, but for a 6kW system, picking poly over mono could save you about \$2,000. Thin-film panels are the budget option at roughly \$0.75 per watt.

How much does a commercial solar system cost?

Commercial solar installations are a great way for companies to lower energy costs. Generally, installing solar panels on businesses costs a bit less per watt because the systems are larger, but the total costs will be higher. In 2025, the average cost for commercial solar panels is just about \$2.00 per watt.

How much does a rooftop solar system cost?

Mounting system: This is what holds rooftop solar panels in place. Costs vary depending on the type of solar installation, but it generally costs between 7 and 20 cents per watt. Electrical wiring and hardware: This includes the wiring, switches and circuit breakers required to connect the solar panel system to your home's electrical system.

How much does a monocrystalline solar system cost?

For a 2,500 sq. ft home, expect to pay \$31,000-\$33,000 (\$21,700-\$23,100 after tax credit) for an 8-9kW system. At this size, spending more on efficient monocrystalline panels often makes sense because you can generate more power with fewer panels.
