How much does electricity cost in Ireland?

Electric Ireland charges 34.75c per kWh and a Standing Charge of EUR251 including VAT. Note- VAT on electricity in Ireland is temporarily reduced from 13.5% to 9% until April 2025. Ireland's national energy-related emissions in 2023 were at their lowest level in over 30 years. Energy-related emissions in 2023 were 31.4 MtCO₂ eq, down 8.3% on 2022 levels, and lower even than those observed during the height of COVID impacts in 2020. Energy-related emissions fell by over 2.8 MtCO₂ eq in 2023 - the largest annual reduction observed in 12 years.
