What is the rated voltage of organic supercapacitors?

Which supercapacitor has highest capacitance?

Rahman et.al fabricated a kind of supercapacitors using Cobalt oxide (Co_2O_3), ammonium peroxydisulfate (APS) and PANI composite material . This supercapacitor provided highest capacitance of 249 F/g, Ed of 31 Wh/kg and Power density of +18 W/kg. They have done more research about PANI composites (Ni-PANI, Cu-PANI, CNF-PANI).

Can graphene be used as a supercapacitor electrode?

Because graphene have high SSA ($2630 \text{ m}^2/\text{g}$) ,theoretically, the Cs of supercapacitor using graphene as an electrode can estimated to be about 550 F/g. So it is considered an excellent material for supercapacitor applications. Fig. 7 shows an overview of layered-stacking graphene assemblies as electrodes for supercapacitors . Fig. 7.

Are supercapacitors better than batteries?

Compared with electrolytic capacitors, supercapacitors has larger specific capacity and higher energy density. Compared with batteries , supercapacitors have higher power density (10-100 times higher than that of batteries) and longer life expectancy (millions of cycles). Fig. 1.
