Out of this allocation, 60 million euros are specifically designated to assist vulnerable households in combating energy poverty. The remaining part of the investment cost can be financed through a subsidized interest rate loan.

They investigated the relationship between household income and electricity expenditure using 945 household interviews located in Athens for the year 2004. They found that family income is positively and linearly associated with electricity expenditure but a U-shape relationship was detected when per capita electricity cost was taken into account.

During the period 1970-1990, Greece's energy demand was marked by a sharp increase close to 5% per year.
