



India installs solar photovoltaic panels

How much solar is installed in India in 2024?

India added 18.5 GW of utility-scale solar and 4.59 GW of rooftop PV in 2024. Waaree Energies led the market with a 14.1% share of solar module shipments. India installed 18.5 GW of utility-scale solar and 4.59 GW of rooftop solar in 2024, according to JMK Research & Analytics' Annual India Solar Report Card for calendar year 2024.

How many rooftop solar installations are there in India in 2024?

Rooftop Solar: India added about 4.59 GW of new rooftop solar capacity in 2024, a 53% increase compared to 2023. This growth can be attributed to the launch of the PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana. Notably, within just 10 months of the scheme's launch, there have been 7 lakh rooftop solar installations across the country.

How much solar power does India have?

India's total installed solar capacity stood at 100.33 GW as of Jan. 31, 2025, with 84.10 GW under implementation and an additional 47.49 GW under tendering. Adani Green is developing the world's largest RE plant at Khavda, Gujarat. India has surpassed 100 GW of installed solar power capacity.

Which state has the most solar installations in India?

Rajasthan, Gujarat, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh are among the top-performing states, contributing significantly to India's total utility-scale solar installations. The rooftop solar sector in India witnessed remarkable growth in 2024, with 4.59 GW of new capacity installed, reflecting a 53% increase compared to 2023.

Utility-Scale Solar: India added about 18.5 GW of new utility-scale solar capacity in 2024, marking an increase of ~2.8 times compared to the annual solar installations of 6.5 GW in 2023. In 2024, Rajasthan leads with 7.09 GW capacity, followed by Gujarat with 4.32 GW and Tamil Nadu with 1.73 GW.

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
