However, Indian modules will still be price competitive in countries like Germany, where the average cost of installing residential solar is approximately \$1.70/Watt. In other words, solar PV modules comprise a minority share of overall costs ...

Key reasons for increasing solar module prices in India & abroad are: Supply Chain Disruptions - Polysilicon is a critical raw material in Solar PV manufacturing. Its reduction in price over the years has been a major factor contributing to decline in solar module prices.

Prices of imported mono PERC PV modules in India have risen by over 35% (Exhibit 1) from around \$0.20 per watt in August 2020 to about \$0.28 per watt in March 2022. This is primarily due to higher polysilicon prices (Exhibit 2), which is a crucial input for PV modules. There are several key reasons for the increase in module prices.
