

Install photovoltaic panels on the north side of the roof

Can you put solar panels on a north-facing roof?

This maximizes the energy production over the course of the year, through both summer and winter. Sometimes, however, the homeowner will want to add modules on the north-facing roof. This may be for aesthetic purposes, or sometimes because the south-facing rooftop isn't fit for solar. The most common rule-of-thumb is that you simply can't do that.

Should a solar system be installed on a north facing roof?

But installing on a north facing roof made absolutely no sense. That's because a north facing solar system typically produces about 56% of the output of a south facing system. Since 2010, the cost of electricity has risen from 11p per kilowatt hour to over 30p per kilowatt hour. That's almost a three-fold increase.

What is the best roof orientation for solar panels?

The main string is facing North, which is the best roof orientation for solar panels. These panels should get the optimum amount of sun throughout the day. The smaller string is facing East. These panels will get 15-20% less sunlight than the panels facing North. Obviously the installer could not fit all the panels on the North facing roof.
