The choice of location is a critical factor during the installation of photovoltaic panels. Roofs--flat or sloped--are the most common installation sites, offering excellent sun exposure and energy production optimization. However, in some cases, such as when the roof is unsuitable, ground installation may be a better option.

Roof forms can be divided into three main types, namely flat, pitched, and curved roofs. The corresponding installation of PV panels also differ (Table 7). Esthetic evaluation, carbon reduction, and power generation are the main factors for consideration in the evaluation of different types of PV roofing.

When installing PV systems on pitched roofs, such as those made of color steel tiles or ceramic tiles, the installation method typically follows the natural slope of the roof. In these cases, the spacing between rows of panels can be determined by considering a maintenance corridor that facilitates easy access for maintenance and inspection.

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There are a number of considerations that need to be made before installing solar panels on a flat roof, as it presents different challenges to a pitched or sloped roof. Firstly, solar panels that have been installed on flat roofs usually need to be tilted upwards to make sure they capture sufficient sunlight.
