How much energy storage does Ireland have?

Image: ESB. ESB Networks has announced that Ireland's electricity grid now has 1GW of energy storage available from different energy storage assets. This figure includes 731.5MW of battery energy storage system (BESS) projects and 292MW from Turlough Hill pumped storage power station - which is celebrating its 50th anniversary this year.

"At times there's no wind and that means at other times you have to have up to 75 per cent renewables on the system, and if the system operator needs to be able to raise the bar from 50 per cent renewable to be able to accommodate 75 per cent renewable they need more system services and that's where we come in with the flywheels and batteries."
