

How can a battery energy storage system improve Ireland's power grid?

When the demand for electricity is high, the stored energy from a battery energy storage system can be released into the grid to help meet the demand. This can contribute towards reducing Ireland's reliance on fossil fuels and improving the stability of the power grid.

How much energy storage does Ireland have?

Image: ESB. ESB Networks has announced that Ireland's electricity grid now has 1GW of energy storage available from different energy storage assets. This figure includes 731.5MW of battery energy storage system (BESS) projects and 292MW from Turlough Hill pumped storage power station - which is celebrating its 50th anniversary this year.

Will ESB build a new battery plant in Dublin?

Meanwhile, State-owned electricity company ESB recently opened a major battery plant at its Poolbeg site in Dublin which will add 75MW of energy storage to help provide grid stability and deliver more renewables onto the market in the Republic.

The Single Electricity Market (SEM) in Ireland is set to see a battery energy storage system (BESS) boom into 2030, with short-to-medium duration capacity forecast by Cornwall Insight to increase fivefold by 2030.
