

Are battery energy storage systems a 'great achievement' in Ireland?

Where is Ireland's first grid-scale battery energy storage system based?

Statkraft has announced that it is to build Ireland's first four-hour grid-scale battery energy storage system (BESS) in Co. Offaly. The 20MW BESS, supplied by global market leader in utility-scale energy storage solutions and services, Fluence, will be co-located with Statkraft's 55.8MW Cushing Wind Farm.

How long can a battery storage system last in Ireland?

This battery-based energy storage system is designed to provide 20MW for up to four hours. Most grid-scale batteries currently deployed in Ireland range from 30 minutes to two hours of energy storage capacity. The longer the duration of battery energy storage capacity, the more benefits it can offer.

Is energy storage a new trend in Ireland?

Despite the fact that energy storage is regarded as relatively new in Ireland, the 2020 goal of 40 per cent renewable electricity and energy storage project developers have been successful in winning contracts in EirGrid's DS3 market.

Will battery storage help Ireland generate 80% renewable electricity by 2030?

Ireland has set a target of generating 80% renewable electricity by 2030. Deployment of battery storage will be capable of responding in milliseconds to frequency changes, importing or exporting electricity from the grid as needed, and helping efficiently stabilise the grid, while guaranteeing reliable electricity supply for users.
