Why do import tariffs increase in Ireland?

As a result, businesses that today incur a nil or low tariff on imports of goods into Ireland from other countries, may find that those tariffs increase as a result of the EU having to put in place protective measures. What should I do?

Can autoproducers export electricity in Ireland?

How will the tariff dispute affect Irish businesses?

Irish businesses should be aware that the tariff dispute could also impact on supply chains beyond EU/US trade. As the US applies new tariff measures on goods imported into the US from other countries around the globe, producers in those countries will look to new markets to supply their goods.

What is a feed-in tariff in Ireland?

This is officially called the Clean Export Guarantee (CEG) Tariff, though most people call it the feed-in tariff. Sometimes you'll hear it called the Clean Export Tariff and Micro-generation Support Scheme too. These all mean the same thing. Who pays the highest feed-in tariff rates in Ireland?

What if the US imposed 20% tariffs on EU goods?

This contrasts with the import of US goods into Ireland, the value of which amounted to 22.5 billion euro in 2024, reflecting an annual decrease of 2%.
