



Is it okay for Moscow to use outdoor power supply

Do I need a power adapter in Russia?

If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter. However, if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Russia, you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer. The standard voltage in Russia is 220 V, and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.

What type of power outlet does Russia use?

Russia uses the same power outlets as most European countries, including Finland, Sweden, France, Germany, and Spain. These outlets are 2-pronged and circular shaped. If your plug is different, you'll need an adapter. The voltage in Russia is between 220V and 240V.

Do I need a voltage converter & plug adapter in Russia?

If you are traveling from North America, you will need a voltage converter and a plug adapter to use your electronic devices in Russia. Most European countries use the same voltage and plug types as Russia, so if you are coming from Europe, you will only need a plug adapter.

Do I need a power converter if I travel to Russia?

If you are traveling to Russia from a country that uses a different voltage or frequency, you will need a power converter to use your electronic devices safely. A power converter will convert the voltage and frequency from the Russian power outlet to the voltage and frequency that your device requires.

What is the voltage in Russia?

Voltage in Russia is between 220V and 240V. Russia uses the same power outlets as most European countries including Finland, Sweden, France, Germany and Spain. If your plug is not 2 pronged and circular shaped, you'll need an adapter.

Do North Americans need an adapter to use electronics in Russia?

No! North Americans will need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for the voltage when traveling to Russia. North American device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Russia. Also, the voltage in Russia is different from North American voltages. Can Europeans use Electronics in Russia without an adapter? Yes!
