How far away should farm equipment be from overhead power lines?

Safe Electricity recommends keeping all equipment at least 10 feet away from overhead power lines, in all directions. Remember to take that minimum clearance into account when raising and lowering farm equipment, and always lower extensions to the lowest setting when moving loads.

How should electrical equipment be maintained?

Electrical equipment must be safe, and properly maintained. Work near electrical equipment, or conductors such as OHPLs should be carried out safely. You should isolate the power supply before carrying out any repair or maintenance work. The key issues are:

Should I isolate my power supply?

You should isolate the power supply before carrying out any repair or maintenance work. The key issues are: Electricity can arc (jump gaps) in certain circumstances when equipment or machinery gets close enough - you do not need to contact OHPLs to receive an electric shock.
