What is the cost of solar electricity in Vietnam?

Last year, Vietnam had a solar LCOE (Levelized Cost of Energy) of \$0.046 per kWh for solar electricity. The cost in the United States was \$0.055 per unit of power, and in Turkey it was \$0.064.

Does Vietnam have a solar power industry?

Vietnam's solar power industry has experienced rapid growth in recent years, driven by favourable government policies and increasing demand for renewable energy. With abundant solar potential due to its geographical location, the country has become a significant player in the Southeast Asian renewable energy market.

How much solar power does Vietnam have?

This included 16 billion kWh from solar power and 7.3 billion kWh from wind energy, according to data from Vietnam Electricity. Solar power, in particular, has seen significant expansion due to the implementation of feed-in tariffs and the increasing adoption of rooftop solar systems.

What is the potential for solar energy in Vietnam?

The potential for solar energy in Vietnam is huge. For concentrated solar power, it is between 60 and 100 GWh per year, while for photovoltaic (PV) systems, it is around 0.8 to 1.2 GWh per year. This potential is driven by Vietnam's high sunlight hours (1,600 to 2,700 hours per year) and average direct normal irradiance (DNI) of 4-5 kWh/m².

Why are solar and wind power prices rising in Vietnam?

While Vietnam's solar and wind power production is historically low, they are set to increase due to high feed-in tariffs of 8.5 cents per kWh for solar and 8.5 cents per kWh for onshore wind power, which are higher than the prices for new coal plants at 7-8 cents per kWh and LNG at a half-cent more than coal.

How much solar PV capacity did Vietnam have last year?

Vietnam has the most installed solar PV capacity in ASEAN after jumping from 134 MW last year to 5.5 GW this year.

A rooftop solar system involves the installation of solar panels on a building's roof with a power capacity that does not exceed one megawatt. As per Vietnam Electricity Group's guidelines (decision 13), (1) feed-in tariff (FiT) prices are only specified for projects with a commercial operation period of up to 24 hours on 31 December 2020.
