How big is Turkey's energy storage capacity?

Turkey's 35 GWh storage capacity accounts for grid-scale projects alone. Global energy storage investments have surpassed 150 GWh. Turkey has already begun installations in Hungary, Bulgaria, and Spain, leveraging its geographic advantage close to Europe.

Global energy storage investments have surpassed 150 GWh. Turkey has already begun installations in Hungary, Bulgaria, and Spain, leveraging its geographic advantage close to Europe. Tokcan highlighted the importance of local expertise in manufacturing, system management, and maintenance to avoid dependency on foreign firms.

What type of energy does Turkey generate?

Approximately 56% of Turkey's electric power generation capacity consists of renewable energy, including hydroelectric, wind, solar, geothermal, and biomass power plants, making Turkey the fifth-largest generator of renewable energy in Europe and the 11th largest in the world.

Does Turkey require energy storage?

Turkey's commitment to add 1GW each of new solar PV and wind each year makes energy storage a necessity. With this rapid renewable energy expansion, Turkey's need for energy storage is coming sooner rather than later.

How big is Turkey's electricity market?

In January, Rolls-Royce announced the awarding of a contract by Polat Enerji, one of Turkey's leading investors in renewable energy. It will supply a 132MWh BESS.
