

How much solar energy does Italy use?

In 2020, energy from the sun covered 8.2% of electricity consumption in Italy (Source "Energy from renewable sources in Italy - Statistical Report 2020", GSE). It should be noted here that solar energy in Italy basically means solar electricity, i.e. photovoltaics.

How much solar power does Italy have in 2023?

Italy brought 1,058 MW of solar photovoltaic (PV) parks in the first quarter of 2023, reaching a cumulative installed capacity of over 26,100 MW, shows data released by the domestic solar energy association, Italia Solare.
