The Japanese government issued an interim report on its "Clean Energy Strategy" in May. While aiming to achieve the goals of carbon neutrality by 2050 and a 46% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions in fiscal 2030, further growth will be achieved by ensuring a stable and affordable energy supply for the future.

In Japan, the extension of subsidies to stand-alone battery storage facilities affirms the Japanese government's commitment to transition to renewable energy. It is expected that the introduction of stand-alone battery facilities will ease grid related issues and mitigate connection related risks faced by renewable energy projects.

The 30MW/120MWh Hirohara Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) is located in Oaza Hirohara, Miyazaki City, Miyazaki Prefecture. It is Eku's first battery in Japan, and the company has agreed a 20-year offtake

agreement for the project with Tokyo Gas.

Japan is targeting reaching a 36% to 38% share of renewable energy on its electricity network by 2030, and METI has identified BESS as a key technology to enable that.

On October 22, 2021, the Government of Japan published the 6th Strategic Energy Plan to show the direction of Japan's energy policy. It explains our climate-related efforts to overcome challenges toward achieving carbon neutrality by 2050. It also covers policies to solve various issues in relation to the energy supply/demand structure of Japan.

LG Chem Ltd. has dominated the storage battery market in Japan. The company has supplied storage systems to 2 of the 6 operational and 5 of the 9 under-construction solar plus storage plants, equating to around 47% of the 15 PV+storage projects in Japan. Hokkaido is the home to 87% of the largest solar plus storage projects in Japan.

Japan's first auction for long-term zero emissions power capacity has attracted strong bidding interest with a plan to install battery storage, as investment in the power storage system is gaining momentum in line with expanded use of fluctuating renewable energy sources.

Other recently deployed or announced Megapack projects include a massive 600 MW/1,600 MWh facility in Melbourne, a 75 MW/300 MWh energy storage site in Belgium, and a 228 MW/912 MWh storage ...

Project financing has been arranged by MUFG Bank representing the first battery storage project they have arranged finance for in Japan. Under the offtake agreement, Eku Energy will own the BESS while Tokyo Gas will own 100% of its operating rights for 20 years, with Eku Energy responsible for the ongoing maintenance of the facility.
